Evacuation Information and Resources

In an Emergency:

If you need to report an emergency, call 911 *before* notifying anyone else. Be prepared to provide:

- 1. Your Name
- 2. Building address
- 3. Exact location(floor, unit #)
- 4. Explanation of the emergency
- 5. Injuries known
- 6. Your contact number

In the event of a fire, there are extinguishers on the front facing side of every building, on either the upstairs or downstairs level.

When evacuating, exit the building orderly.

- Regularly check your fire alarms and carbon monoxide detectors within your units.
- Keep a box ready with any valuables, documents, photos etc. that are important to save in the case of an emergency.
- Pack an emergency pack and store it in your car.
- Locate a hotel, family or friend that you can reliably stay at in an emergency situation.
- Do NOT hesitate to leave when it is mandatory
